CLASS NOTES FOR THIS YEAR

You will find some classes designated A or B. These are NOT levels, but just a way for us to track two classes at the same level. An exception to that would be if the class meets more than once a week, you <u>must</u> choose an A or B for both classes to register in. Some classes have age requirements and others are by placement. Some classes require multiple classes per week. See Schedule for details.

Ballet 4-5-6 dancers in Nutcracker are required to take 3 classes per week. Enroll in regular class for your level and then choose Combo ballet 4-5-6 class or Body Mechanics.

Class Times or conflicts: We did our best to cross check all classes and dancers so you can take all classes that you have taken in the past. If a conflict arises, let the office know and we will see if there are any adjustments we can make for you.

NEW CLASSES: **Musical Theatre**: For dancers levels 2+ who are interested in productions, such as school tour. Enhances acting for Nutcracker. **Ballroom/Partner dancing**, such as Salsa, Swing, etc.: Day and Time TBA. **Modern 3-4 Combo class**: Highly recommended for level 3 & 4 dancers, to work on lifts and choreography.

DANCEWEAR/SHOES IN BALLET & TAP CLASSES

Female ballet dancers are required to purchase the color of leotard for their level. See dress code listed on schedule page of web site. Dancers in Ballet 2 and up should purchase a split sole ballet soft shoe. If you already have full sole shoes, they are fine until you replace them. All ballet dancers, level 2+ should have a nude leotard and level 3+ should have a black camisole leotard. Beginning tap dancers should purchase their shoes through the office. The teachers have requested a specific shoe to be worn. You may purchase other items from your favorite dancewear source or order through the office.
